EXTRA LENTEN SERVICES

Because Great Lent is predominately a penitential season and a time of increased awareness of God through prayer, besides Wednesday evening Presanctified Liturgies, Friday night’s Akathist, and the three Saturday Memorial Divine Liturgies, this year I am adding a number of opportunities for parishioners to come, pray, and meditate quietly in church.

- **Psalter for an Hour:** on Monday mornings, come and listen to the ancient Psalter chanted as you sit quietly and reflect. Or, if the spirit should move you, come and help chant during this time.
- **Small Compline:** on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, Small Compline will be read, which lasts about 15 minutes. Then Confessions will be heard. A great way to prepare for ones’ confession.
- **Sixth Hour:** On Friday’s at noon - the traditional time of the Sixth Hour - we will read this short service which, coincides with the day and time that Jesus was nailed to the Cross - and also allow opportunities for Confessions.

Make this year’s Lenten Journey a success by taking advantage of these extra times to gather and pray in church, as well as, to come and confess your sins.

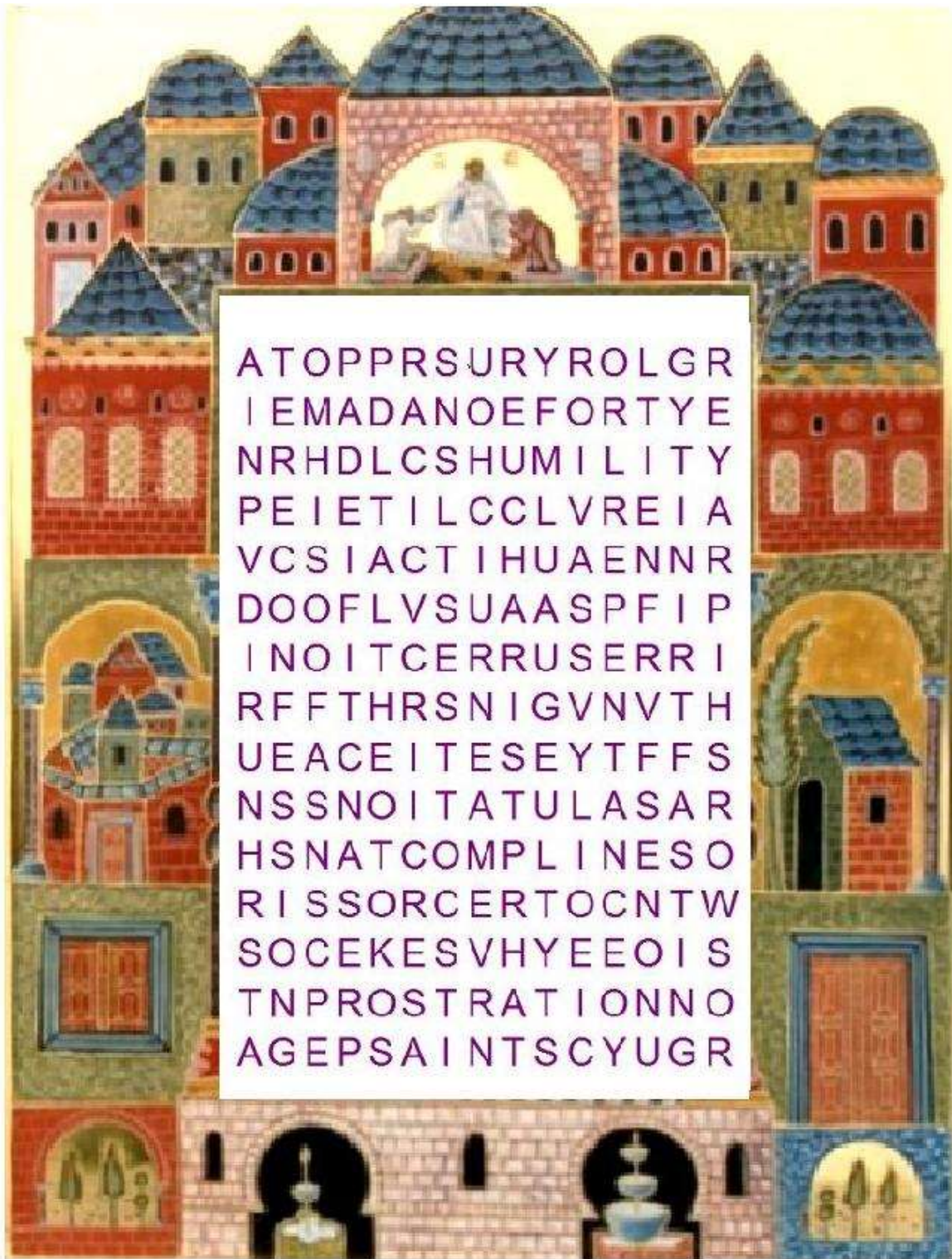
