PASCHAL SERVICE SCHEDULE UPDATE

Because of the overwhelming success of last year's Sunrise Pascha services, I and the Board of Trustees were approached by numerous parishioners who asked if we could hold our hold Pascha this way again. A straw vote was taken and the vast majority, were in favor of doing the Sunrise Service. And of those who voted "no," the majority of these parishioners wanted us to go through the cycle (nocturns, matins, and liturgy) at midnight. Only a small handful of voters were desires of splitting the services as had been done in the past.

Therefore, Paschal Services will take place at 7:00 a.m. on Sunday, April 8 – followed by the traditional blessing of baskets and Paschal social at Woodside.

EXTRA LENTEN SERVICES

Because Great Lent is predominately a penitential season and a time of increased awareness of God through prayer, besides Wednesday evening Presanctified Liturgies, Friday night's Akathist, and the three Saturday Memorial Divine Liturgies, this year I am adding a number of opportunities for parishioners to come, pray, and meditate quietly in church.

- **Psalter for an Hour:** on Monday mornings, come and listen to the ancient Psalter chanted as you sit quietly and reflect. Or, if the spirit should move you, come and help chant during this time.
- **Small Compline:** on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, Small Compline will be read, which lasts about 15 minutes. Then Confessions will be heard. A great way to prepare for ones' confession.
- **Sixth Hour:** On Friday's at noon - the traditional time of the Sixth Hour - we will read this short service which, coincides with the day and time that Jesus was nailed to the Cross - and also allow opportunities for Confessions.

Make this year's Lenten Journey a success by taking advantage of these extra times to gather and pray in church, as well as, to come and confess your sins.
