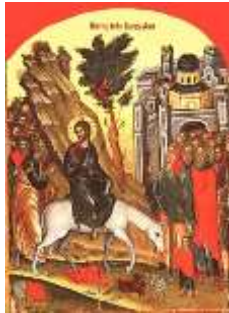

## **UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ON MILL RD**

Please note that starting on Monday, April 9, there will be a major road repair starting on Mill Road that will impact your ability to get to church. **\*\*THERE IS A MAP IN THE BACK OF THE BULLETIN TO SHOW THE NEW TRAFFIC PATTERN DURING THIS CONSTRUCTION\*\***. Mill Road (south of Wallings) will be SOUTHBOUND traffic ONLY. Northbound will be diverted to West Mill Road (across I-77). All traffic leaving the church will head south on Mill and need to cross I-77 at Lacy Lane to head Northbound. Construction is expected to last 3-4 weeks.

## **THE MORE YOU KNOW**

In the Orthodox Christian world, the Feast of our Lord's Resurrection is referred to as **Pascha**, the Greek transliteration of the Hebrew word Pesach, meaning Passover. As was foreshadowed by the Passover account of the Old Testament, Jesus becomes the supreme Passover (Paschal) Lamb sacrificed in a New Covenant for the remission of our sins and the salvation of our soul; laying down His life, lying in a tomb, and rising on the Third Day so that we, too, might have a way to escape or "pass over" from death to life.

The word "**Easter**" is of Germanic origin and is derived from the name of the pagan female goddess, Eostre: goddess of the spring month of April. Because the celebration of Christ's Resurrection almost exclusively falls during that time frame, the Western world unfortunately began to identify the Paschal Feast by the calendar month; thus inadvertently misconstruing the ultimate Christian Feast with pagan terminology.

# EAST MILL DETOUR – WORK TO BEGIN SECOND WEEK OF APRIL
