50 Person Limit for Divine Liturgy

The Board of Trustees lifted their temporary limit of 30 people in church, back to the 50 as allowed by Archbishop Paul. All February liturgies have 50 spots available to sign up for.

We will continue using the Sign Up Genius software. **You may now sign up for ONE Sunday per month in advance. After you've signed up for one Sunday, you must adhere to the 4pm rule to attend other Liturgies.**

UPDATE TO SIGN UP POLICY

As of 4pm EACH Saturday evening, if there are any available spots for Liturgy the FOLLOWING MORNING, you MAY sign up to attend, even if you have already attended a liturgy in weeks prior. YOU STILL NEED TO SIGN UP so we have an accurate count – but you must wait until at least 4pm the night before the service.
