Attendance Limit for Services 80 Upstairs and 60 Downstairs

Our parish is now allowing 80 people in the Church and also opening the church basement to allow an additional 60 people in the Lower Level.

We will continue using the Sign Up Genius software. You may now sign up for THREE Sunday Liturgies per month in advance. After you've signed up for the allotted amount of services, you must adhere to the 4pm rule to attend other Sunday services. Please feel free to attend ANY other services as you are able. There is no restriction on your attendance at any other service. Finally, the ONLY other services that will require a Sign Up (beyond the Sunday liturgy) are the Presanctified Liturgies.

UPDATE TO SIGN UP POLICY

As of 4pm the day before any service, if there are any available spots for services the NEXT DAY, you MAY sign up to attend, even if you have already attended a liturgy in weeks prior. YOU STILL NEED TO SIGN UP so we have an accurate count – but you must wait until at least 4pm the night before the service.

Confessions via Telephone

Fr. John will be hearing confessions over the phone this week from **6-6:45pm on Tuesday** evening and from **10:00 am until 11:00 am Wednesday**. Please call the church at **440.526.5192** between those hours to have your confession heard. All calls will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis. Afternoon and Evening hours will be added throughout April. As always, confessions are heard before and after services as well.

Receiving Holy Communion at Presanctified Liturgies

There are three ways in which to prepare to receive Holy Communion at an evening Presanctified liturgy during the Great Lenten season, depending upon your personal abilities.

- Ideally one is expected to keep a complete and total fast (no food or drink) for the entire day and then partake of a light Lenten meal following the service.
- If one is unable to keep such a rigorous fast, you may eat a small, fast-worthy breakfast (such as tea and toast) but have no further food or drink until after that evening's liturgy.
- If one is unable to keep either of the previous two formats, it is permissible to eat a very light Lenten meal at noon and then begin the fast (no food or drink) with rigor.

This third option, however, should not be considered the norm, but rather the exception, and is generally practiced only by the weak, infirm, or very aged.

Please Note:

- Masks must be worn during all services and social distancing needs to be enforced.
- Eighty (80) parishioners are allowed in church. Sixty (60) will be allowed in the church's lower level to view the service. All others may gather at Woodside to also view the service.
- It is our sincere hope that by trying to accommodate as many as possible to be on our campus, all those in the lower level and at Woodside may proceed to the main church to receive Holy Communion on Palm Sunday and Pascha.
- With only six (6) singers allowed in the choir, and with little chances of holding choir rehearsals, the hymns and music may be a bit more simplistic die to the lack of voices and ranges. Therefore, we encourage YOU to help sing and add exuberance to these services.
- Processions will be curtailed this year to the bare minimum. Although we have not finalized anything at this time, we may do the procession indoors as in instances of rain or snow.
- The blessing of baskets will take place following both, the midnight and Sunday morning service. Baskets may be brought to the front of the church per usual, but we ask that you distance yourselves adequately.
- Per the ruling of Archbishop Paul, if families wish to eat from their baskets while on the church property, they may do so as a family unit only. There is to be no sharing of Paschal food or beverages (including alcohol).

We realize that these attempts may not appeal to every individual or appease everyone. The Board of Trustees are trying our very best to accommodate as many people as possible and include them in the Paschal celebration. After much deliberation and prayer, the Board of Trustees ultimately decided on this as the plan while we still navigate these unchartered times.
