Attendance in church will no longer have limitations. In addition, please see the following updates to the rules as directed by Archbishop Paul:

- Masks are no longer mandated for those persons who *have been fully vaccinated*.
- Those who are not fully vaccinated should (not must) continue to wear masks in order to protect themselves and others from potential exposure.
- Those who have not yet received a vaccination or those who choose to not receive a vaccine, assume all and any risk by entering the temple without a mask.
- Understanding some concern regarding ONE communion spoon, Archbishop Paul has granted our parish a ONE MONTH exception. We will continue with multiple spoons during the month of June. In July, we are REQUIRED by Archbishop Paul to return to ONE communion spoon.
- Coffee Hour will return to the church basement on June 6. Guidelines regarding serving and handling of food will need to be followed
