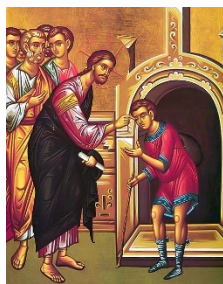

BLIND MAN

The sixth Sunday of Holy Pascha is observed by the Orthodox Church as the Sunday of the Blind Man. The day commemorates the miracle of Christ healing the man who was blind since birth. The biblical story of this event is found in the Gospel of Saint John 9:1-41.



The icon of the Sunday of the Blind Man depicts the biblical story of Christ healing the man who was blind since birth. Our Lord is shown placing the clay on the eyes of the man. He is with his disciples who are questioning Christ about the source of the man's affliction. The blind man is shown with his hand outstretched toward Christ expressing his faith and willingness to receive healing and grace from the Son of God. Our Lord has in His hand a scroll, which directs us to His statements, "I am the light of the world," (John 9:5), and "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed," (Luke 4:18)..

June Attendance at Services – No Limits

We will NO LONGER be requiring sign ups for services. With the new video system, we will also have the TV in the lower level available for those who wish to stay downstairs and participate that way.

BEGINNING ON SUNDAY, JUNE 6, 2021, our attendance in church will no longer have a limit. In addition, please see the following updates to the rules as directed by Archbishop Paul:

- Masks are no longer mandated for those persons who *have been fully vaccinated*.
- Those who are *not fully vaccinated* should (not must) continue to wear masks in order to protect themselves and others from potential exposure.
- Those who have not yet received a vaccination or those who choose to not receive a vaccine, assume all and any risk by entering the temple without a mask.
- Understanding some concern regarding ONE communion spoon, Archbishop Paul has granted our parish a ONE MONTH exception. We will continue with multiple spoons during the month of June. In July, we are REQUIRED by Archbishop Paul to return to ONE communion spoon.
- Coffee Hour will return to the church basement on June 6. Guidelines regarding serving and handling of food will need to be followed.
