There are no organized activities and those coming for open gym should bring their own toys/balls/equipment, etc. We are simply opening the doors and giving you a chance to come utilize the gym space.

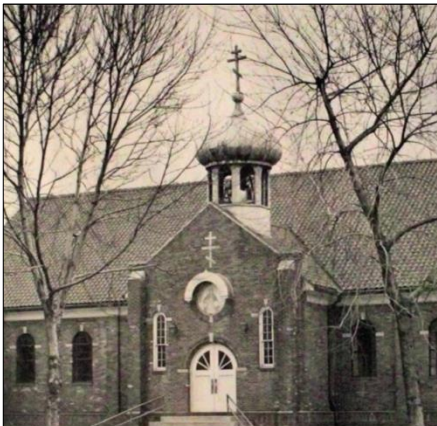
**Perfect For:**
