100th ANNIVERSARY OUTREACH – COOKING & SERVING MEALS

NEW LITURGICAL ITEMS NEEDED:

With our 100th Anniversary fast approaching, there are a number of liturgical items needed to help replace those which are old and worn. We are looking at replacing some clergy vestments, altar boy robes, altar cloths, altar covers, as well as some new chalice sets and other liturgical pieces.
