INTERESTED IN ORTHODOX MEDIA AND MINISTRY?

Ancient Faith's Lampstand Institute is an introductory media training forum for Orthodox Christians aged 18-23 who are interested in learning skills in digital media and applying them to the service of the Church.

At Lampstand, a group of students will gather to learn the essentials of podcasting and video production and the "why" and "how" of Orthodox media ministry. Students will execute their own digital media projects under the direction of Ancient Faith's staff and network. Upon the program's conclusion, participants will leave with foundational ministry experience, technical and creative skills, and career mentors. The weekend will include sessions on podcasting, recording & audio production, video production and concept, marketing, and media and ministry, and open work sessions for recording radio material, refining a personal project, and preparing a live radio broadcast.
