

THE SUNDAY OF THE PARALYTIC

The fourth Sunday of Holy Pascha is observed by the Orthodox Church as the Sunday of the Paralytic. The day commemorates the miracle of Christ healing a man who had been paralyzed for thirtyeight years. The biblical story of the event is found in the Gospel of John 5:1-15.



The icon of the Sunday of the

Paralytic depicts the biblical story of the Christ healing the paralytic. Our Lord, accompanied by His disciples, is shown blessing the paralytic. The man has risen and taken up his bed as commanded by Christ. The paralytic is bowing toward the Lord in reverence and in grattitude for the great miracle that has been done. In the background of the icon is the pool where the infirmed came for healing.




