- The special parish meeting will require a vote for the Woodside business operations. We encourage all parish members to attend and participate in this important discussion.

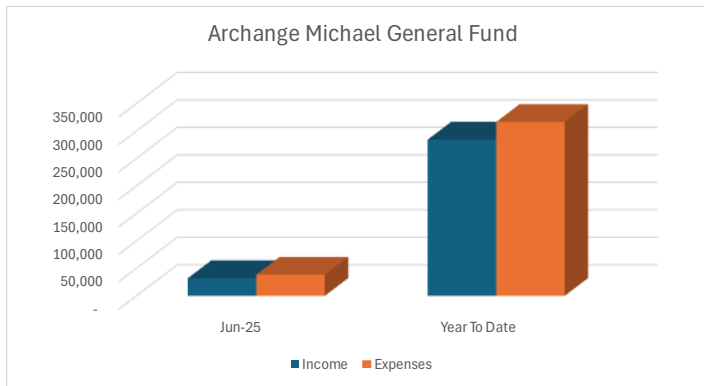

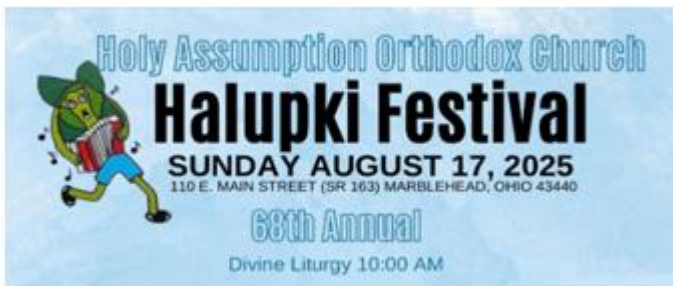
