- ❖ Cupola painted gold
- ❖ Front walk pavers reset in new sand and limestone.
- ❖ Sanded and painted the chapel floor.
- ❖ Repainted the Iconostasis white and repainted the gold trim.
- ❖ We were also able to make a walking path around the side of the chapel with rocks, sand & limestone.
- ❖ I constructed a new cross for the chapel from the dome taken down at St. Theodosius Cathedral. The 113-year-old wood and materials are now part of St. Vladimir's Chapel.

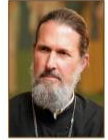
