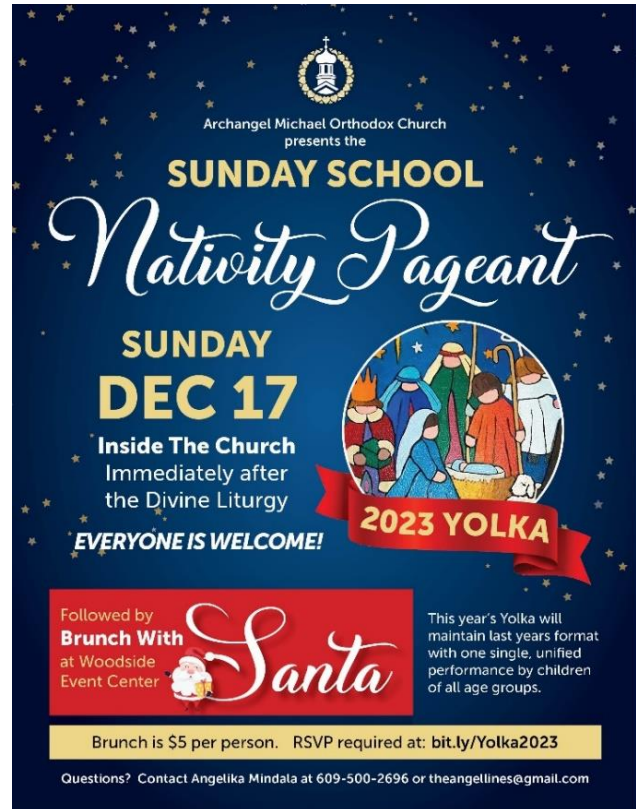

HELPING THOSE IN NEED

"for I was hungry, and you gave me food; I was thirsty, and you gave Me drink; . . . I was naked, and you clothed Me . . . in as much as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me."

At Archangel Michael, you have at least two ways to heed our Lord's words.

1. Join St. Michael's Samaritans. The Samaritans meet the 2nd Wednesday of every month starting with a short Molieben service when we pray for the sick and shut-ins. We then make 100-120 bag lunches which we take to St. Herman's. A Lenten potluck lunch and fellowship follow. In December we package and deliver boxes of cookies to all parishioners over the age of 80. A handmade blanket is given to all first-time moms. We also try to visit parishioners who are ill or in nursing homes. JOIN US! For more information contact Pat Hanchuk (440-885-4671) or Kathy Kovalak (440-842-6639).
2. During our 100th anniversary year, a group of parishioners started cooking and serving dinner at St. Herman's. We have decided to continue this ministry. We serve dinner on the 3rd Monday of every month, serving about 50-75 people. We arrive at St. Herman's at 5 pm and are usually done about 6:15 pm. We can always use more help. NEW LITURGICAL ITEMS NEEDED:
