Program Requirements, Information and Checklist

The Scholarship Committee will place strong emphasis on the applicant's church involvement when making decisions.

Applicants can use this checklist to help ensure all necessary requirements for the Scholarship Program have been completed. Do **not** submit this checklist with the application.

1. _____ Parishioner in good standing

Applicant must be a parishioner in good standing of Archangel Michael Orthodox Church for a minimum of one year prior to submitting the application.

2. _____ Holy Confession and Holy Communion

Applicant must partake of Holy Confession and Holy Communion at Archangel Michael Orthodox Church at least once during the past twelve months prior to submitting the application, with a special effort during Great Lent. If this is not possible, contact Father John Memorich before submitting the application.

3. _____ 2023 (and 2024 if applicable) Church Stewardship Program

Applicant must participate in the stewardship (pledge) program, either individually or as a part of the family pledge.

4. _____ Church service project

Applicant must contact Father John Memorich to arrange and complete a church service project before the deadline or mutually agreed upon date if deadline is not possible.

5. _____ Entering or currently enrolled in an accredited post-secondary program working toward a degree or certificate on a full or part-time basis.

Post-secondary schools include accredited trade schools, technical schools, vocational schools, business schools, colleges, universities, medical schools and Orthodox seminaries. Please consult the Scholarship Committee Co-Chair if you have any questions regarding the school.

Applicant who is a full-time college student may apply every year they are in school, but scholarships will be awarded up to five years towards a Bachelor's degree, two years towards a Master's degree, and two years towards a Doctorate. This is a total of nine years maximum. Contact the Scholarship Committee Co-Chairperson to inquire about number of times a part-time student can apply for the scholarship.

The Scholarship Committee will use their discretion to determine amount of scholarship partially based on length of program and full-time or part-time status of student.
