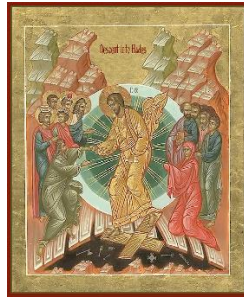

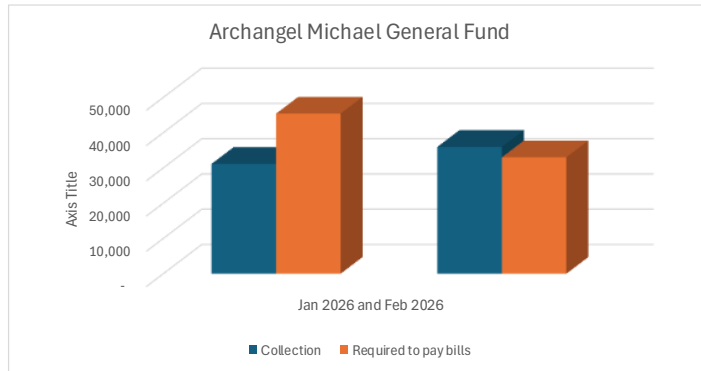

One of the greatest Paschal traditions of the Christian Faith is to joyously proclaim “*Christ is Risen!*” in as many languages as possible. This not only reminds us of our obligation to fulfill our Lord’s command to go forth and proclaim His gospel to all nations (Matt. 28:19), but epitomizes the very *catholicity* of Christ’s Holy Church.
