To date, we continue to operate with a surplus and have already achieved nearly one-third of our goal to reduce the \$71,290 budget deficit. Year-to-date, we have generated a surplus of \$14,528 and are performing approximately \$24,000 better than this time last year.

Our Lenten journey was enriched by meaningful testimonials on almsgiving. If you have not seen these testimonials they can be viewed in the April Archangel newsletter. Five pledging units have formally reached out to increase their pledge to the church. Others have simply given more in their weekly offering. We will continue to report on our progress to improve our financial position each month.

As summer approaches, many of us will be traveling, taking vacations, and spending time away from home and our church community. Please keep in mind that the parish's expenses continue regardless of attendance. Your ongoing contributions remain important and play a vital role in supporting the continued operations and ministry of our parish.
