To date, we continue to operate with a surplus and have already achieved nearly one-third of our goal to reduce the \$71,290 budget deficit. Year-to-date, we have generated a surplus of \$14,294 and are performing approximately \$21,000 better than this time last year. We did not make any forward progress in May - with summer approaching and decreased attendance predicted this is a concern.

As summer progresses, many of us will be traveling, taking vacations, and spending time away from home and our church community. Please keep in mind that the parish's expenses continue regardless of attendance. Your ongoing contributions remain important and play a vital role in supporting the continued operations and ministry of our parish.
