To date, we continue to operate with a surplus and have already achieved over half of our goal to reduce the \$71,290 budget deficit. Year-to-date, we have generated a surplus of \$5,332 and are performing approximately \$33,000 better than this time last year.

As summer progresses, many of us will be traveling, taking vacations, and spending time away from home and our church community. Please keep in mind that the parish's expenses continue regardless of attendance. Your ongoing contributions remain important and play a vital role in supporting the continued operations and ministry of our parish.

SALE OF WOODSIDE AND PROPERTY

Discussion continues toward the sale of the Woodside property. Upon the recommendation of a parishioner, and the approval of the Board of Trustees, we engaged joint legal counsel (Ed Muse Law and Collins & Hagenbush) to represent us in the sale of Woodside assets (liquor license, use of Woodside name, customer database, etc.), and the sale of the Event Center and undeveloped property. We anticipate the next step includes a formal Purchase Agreement between the buyer and Archangel Michael Church. Please direct any

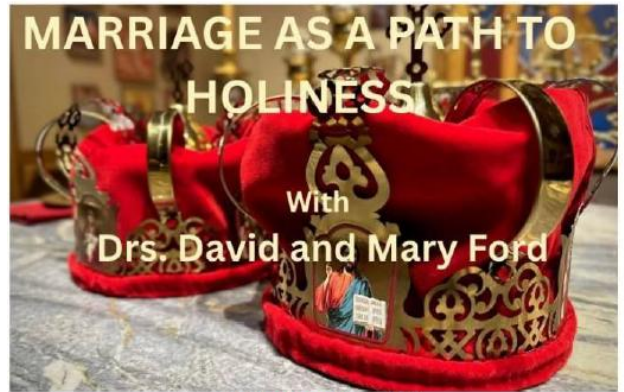
