We finished August with a shortfall of almost \$14,000. Despite this, we remain \$28,000 ahead of where we were at this time last year and have now made it two-thirds of the way toward achieving a break-even budget. To date we have had to draw \$25,000 from Endowment to pay our bills.

Thank you for your continued generosity and support as we work together toward our goal of ending the year on solid financial footing.
